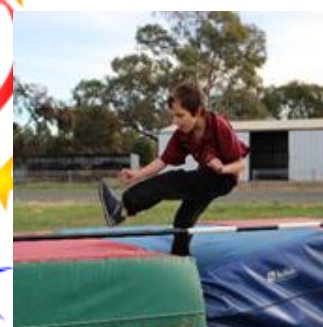
## Infants & Primary Sport

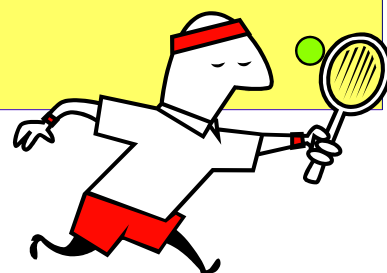
