## **Bland Shire Community Methamphetamine (Ice) Forum**

Bland Shire Council is holding a community forum to educate community members about the dangers associated with the drug methamphetamine/ice. It is well documented that the use and availability of methamphetamine in rural communities across the country is on the rise.
