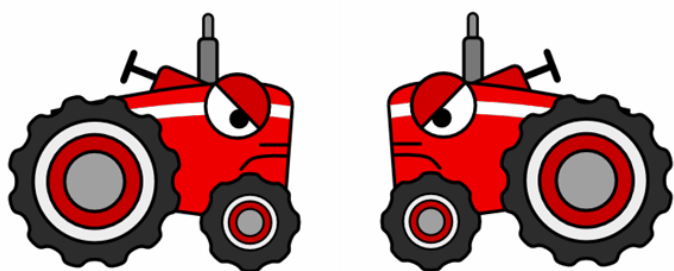

Registration

Registration will be \$10 for Under 18's and \$20 for Over 18's.

For insurance purposes registration forms must be filled in and Registration paid before you take the court.

There will also be a \$10 deposit for your singlet which will be returned at the end of the competition.

Basketball Rules

- Games will be 2 x 20 minute halves.
- 5 players per side on the court, with no more than 3 men on the court for each team at once.

Netball Rules

- Games will be 4 x 10 minute quarters.
- 5 players per side on the court, with no more than 3 men on the court for each team at once.
- Players must change position after each quarter and can only play each position once per game.
