Ungarie Central School certainly did our bit on **Clean Up Australia Day**. Each class were allocated an area of the school they were responsible for. The school looked a treat!



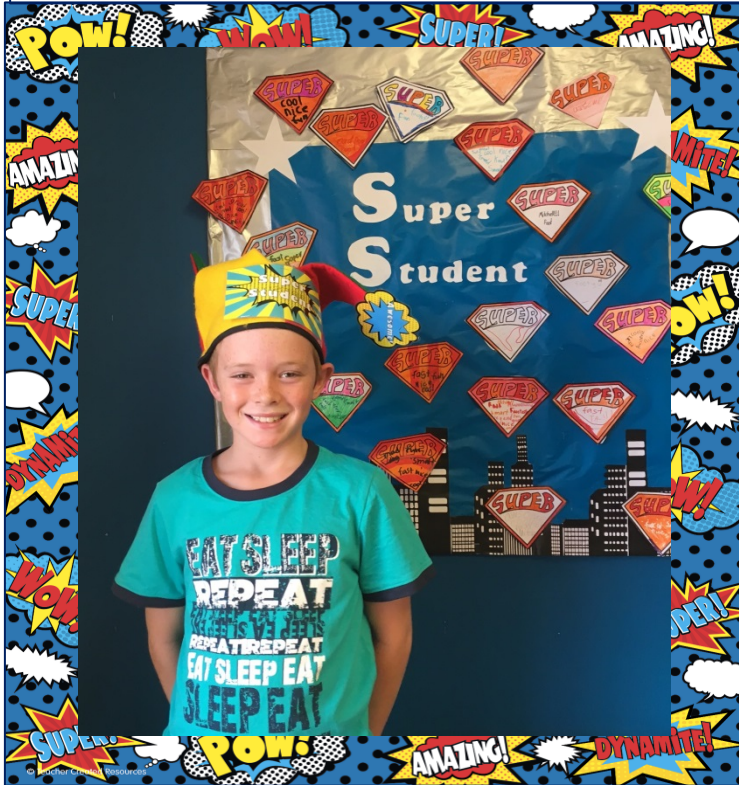
