## YEAR 2/3/4 MATHS

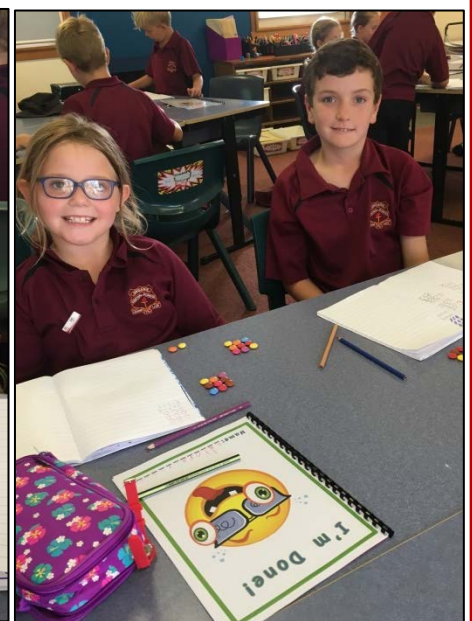

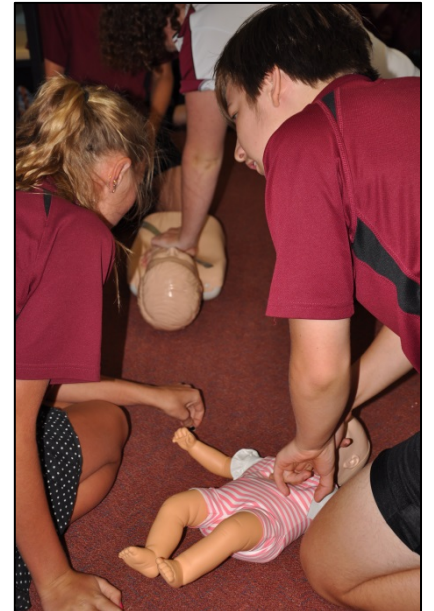

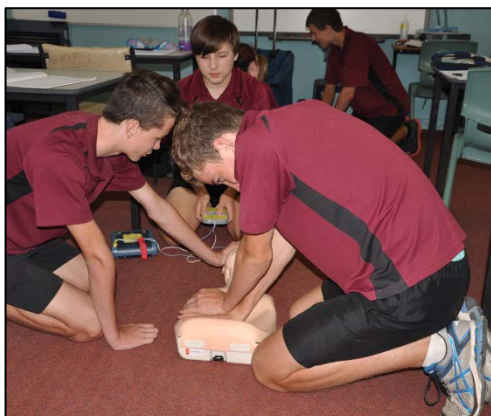
