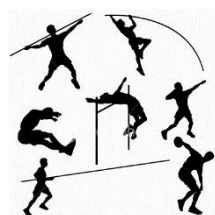

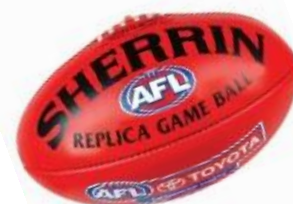

Games will be 25mins with a hooter to ring at the end of each game 5 minute break between each game with a hooter to commence each round

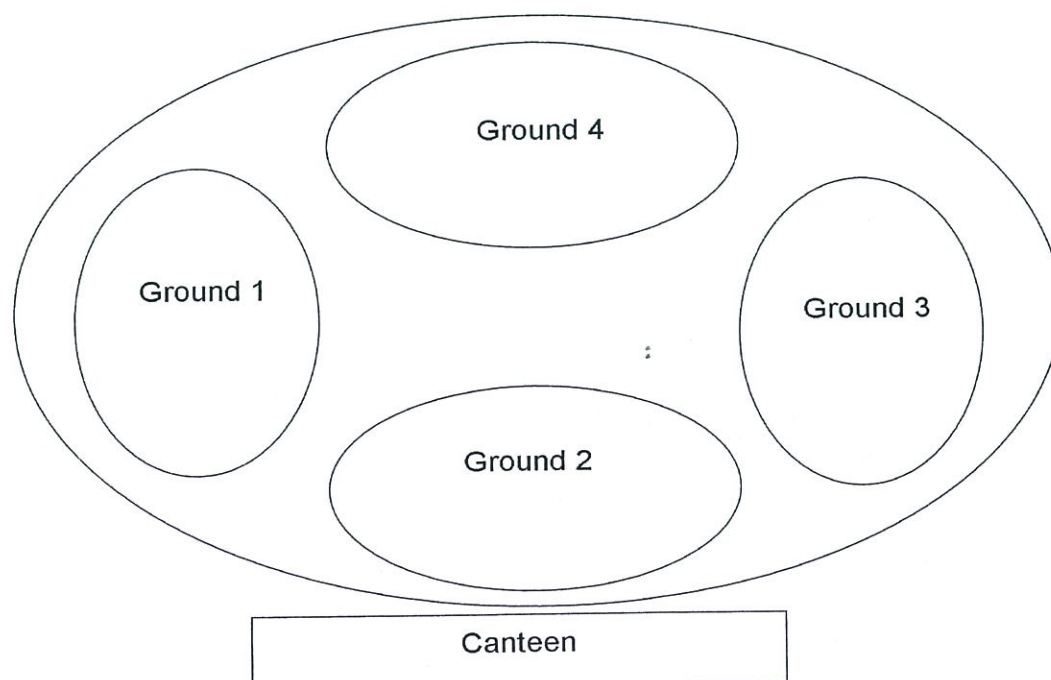
