Ungarie Central School Cross Country 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place getters. Results were published in a previous newsletter.

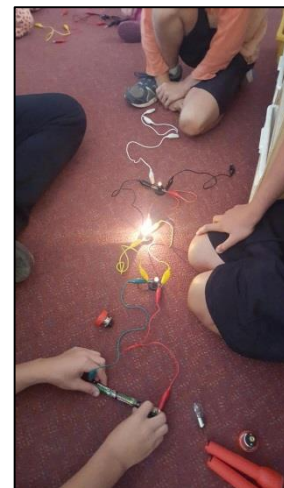
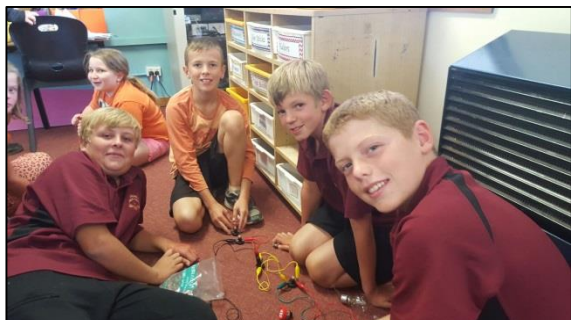
Yr 12 students have purchased their 2016 jumpers recently. They look fantastic with their school uniform and will be a great memento of their time at school and finishing Yr 12.

Year 5/6 visited the classroom of Year 2/3/4 and taught them how to make 'God's Eyes'. It was great fun for all the students and they achieved some great results.



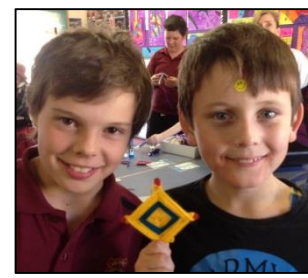
