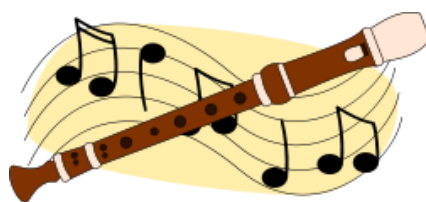

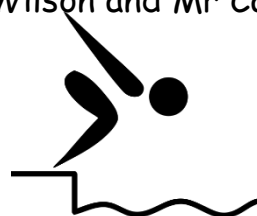
It would be appreciated if these notes could be returned by Wednesday 12th December.
