It's been a busy start to the term and it looks like it's going to get even busier!

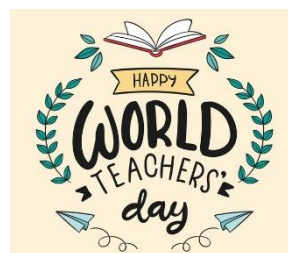

The students enjoyed meeting new people and taking part in the fun and engaging activities. The ASPIRE team will visit UCS next Wednesday to work with Kindergarten to Year 11, which students always enjoy.

Braden Payne is attending the Upper Hunter Beef Bonanza in Scone from Thursday to Sunday this week, with students from Condobolin HS and Lake Cargelligo CS. The students will be involved in a number of competitions including parading, meat judging and cattle judging.

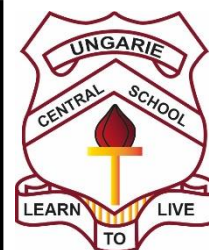

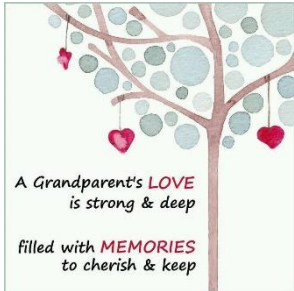

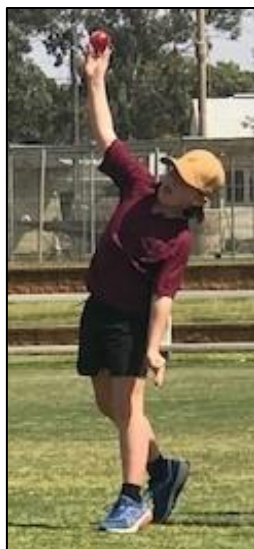

This is where you come in.

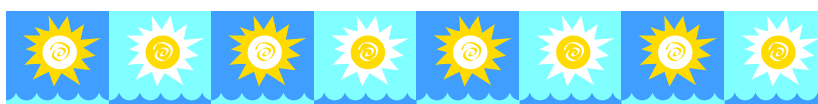
