We are currently looking for a HSC exam supervisor. The exams will be from 17/10/19 to 11/11/19, however you will not be required every day.

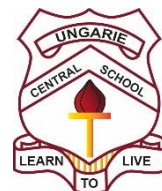
We are looking for someone who has:

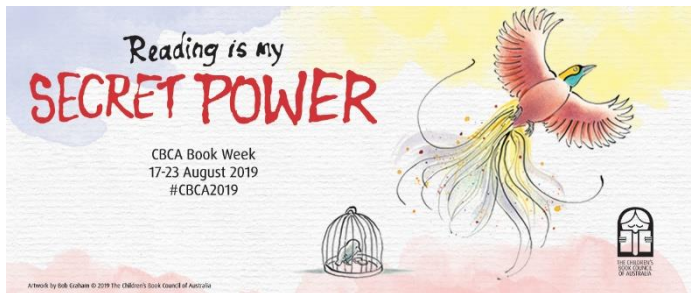
Lake Cowal Conservation Centre

The teams competing on the day were Ungarie, Coolamon and Ardlethan.

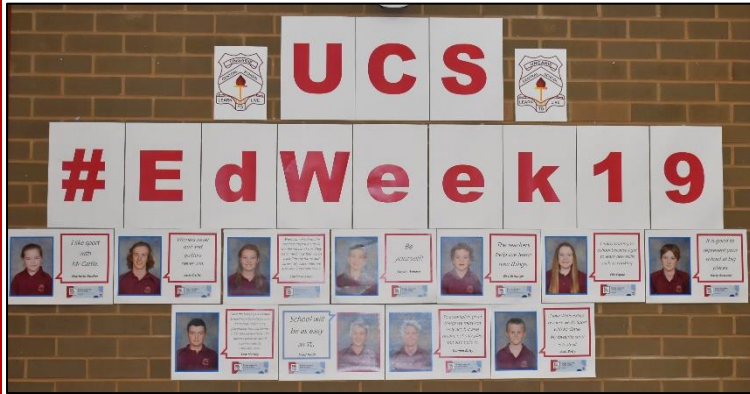

This put Ungarie pretty much out of contention to advance to Dubbo (the top two teams from this day made it), but they continued to try hard against the strong Ardlethan outfit.

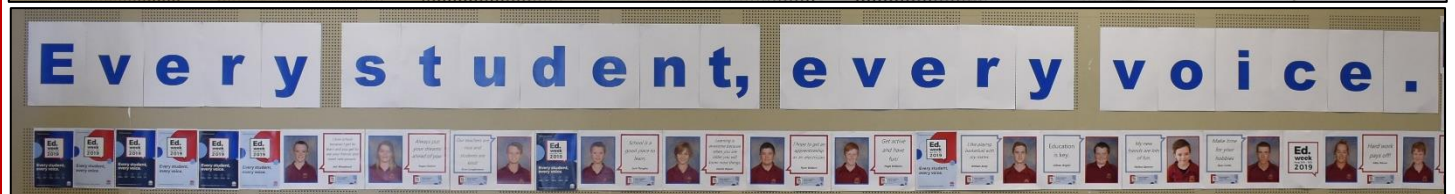
Ungarie played better in their second game, although losing in a tight match 11-6.

EDUCATION WEEK



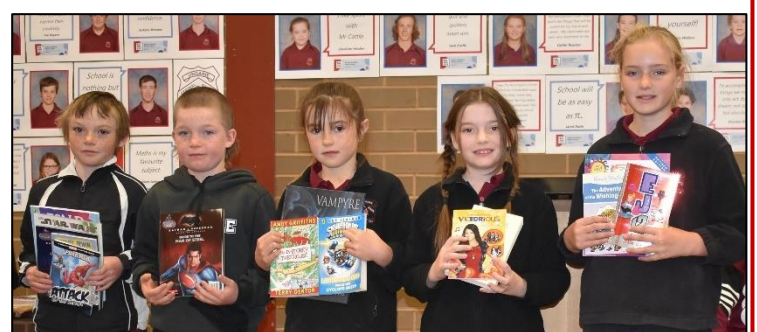

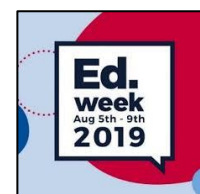
