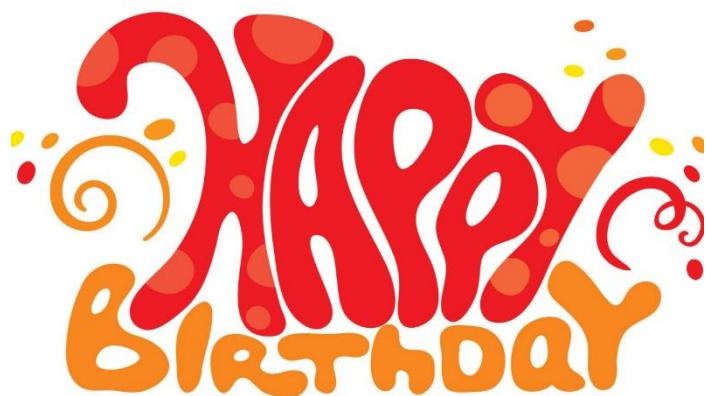
Students and teachers have been working hard to finish show entries and displays. Please take time to look in the pavilion at the Ungarie Show on Saturday to see our display.

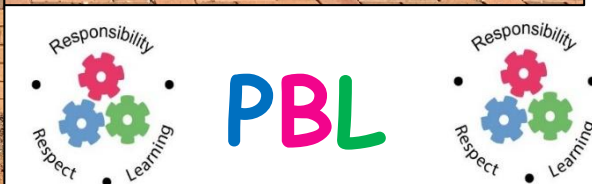
