Until next year, Terrie Payne We look forward to seeing students when school resumes on Wednesday 5th February 2020.






Carols in the Park






On Thursday 5th December Year 6 students completed their orientation day into the secondary department of UCS. Students attended an English, Maths, Science

Should the weather prove inclement, the carols will be moved to the Memorial Hall. Don't forget to bring a seat or blanket, and your best singing voice!

















