Ungarie Central School students close to the age of 16 or over have again been able to participate in the driver-training program run at school. The Licence program provides students with access to industry accredited instruction at a minimal cost. It also gives them lifelong driving skills, which will both assist with making responsible road users as well as making students more work ready. The aim is to help students become driver ready for their Provisional *(P)*test.

The driver trainer program also assists students with all aspects of driving and help towards completing the compulsory 120 hours log book driver practice required by the student to obtain their *Ps*. The lessons are provided during school hours and cover all aspects of driver training such as all the internal aspects of the car, multi-point turn, hill start, reverse parking, parallel parking, approaching roundabouts, open road driving and many more.

Throughout 2020 Jack Wells and Tom Roscarel have gained their 'P Plates', Willam Batty, Kadee Gerhard-Scali, Michelene Izzard, Rachel Spencer, Abby Wason and Jye Hoskinson have practiced driving on their 'L Plates' and Jack Crofts, Jett Brew and Regan and Audrey Hukins have been working towards gaining their 'L's'.

Janene Richards from Condobolin, who is a fully qualified driving instructor brings her fully equipped dual-control, manual transmission vehicle for students to use. A big thank you to Janene for her patience and assistance with the driver education program.

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
