From the Principal's desk...

Well done to our primary swimmers who competed at the Lower Lachlan PSSA swimming carnival last Friday. Special congratulations to Olivia Rossiter and Hannah Wilson who were age champions. A number of our students have now qualified to swim at the Western Area carnival on March 13.

There is quite a bit of maintenance work going on at school at the moment. The Music room verandah is currently being replaced and the Maths room verandah will be fixed. This year, a number of classrooms will have a fresh coat of paint and there'll be new carpet in some of the buildings. Over the coming months we have new air conditioners going into the Food Tech room, Science Lab, Library and Computer room, as part of the Cooler Classrooms initiative.

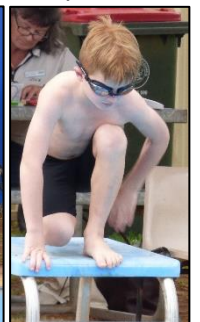

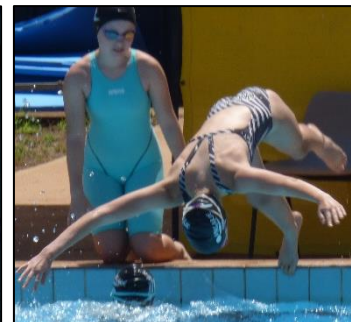
