★ Attendance ★

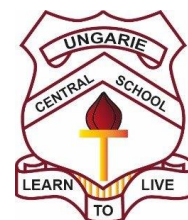

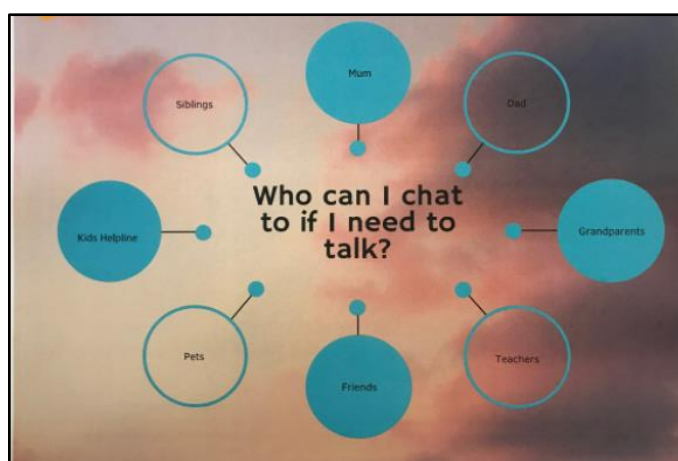
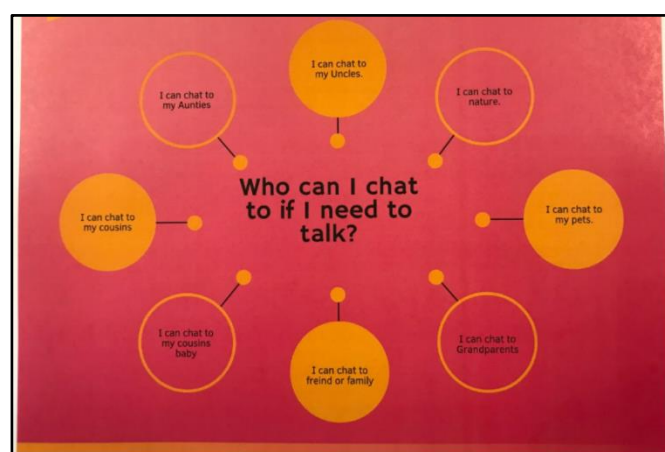
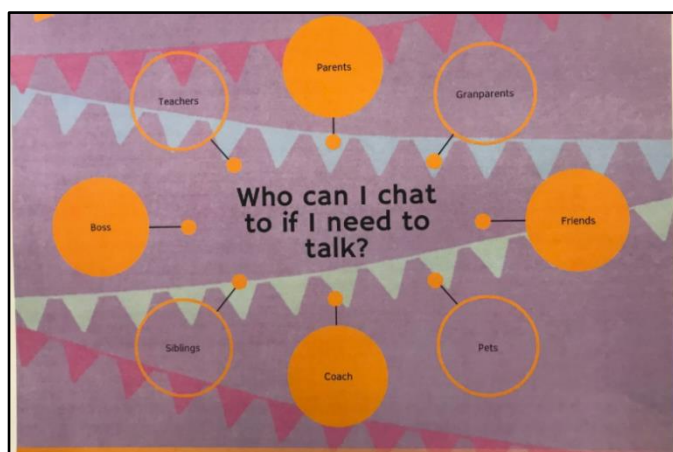
The Resilience Project in Stage 3.
