We currently have a number of students with COVID-19 across our primary classes. We are asking parents to please remain vigilant about testing students with symptoms and keeping them at home, even if the test is negative, until all symptoms are clear. We will continue to send students home who show symptoms during the day. More tests have been sent home with students and we encourage you to test your children as a precaution, which I know many of you have done. There are multiple symptoms that you need to watch out for including fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting, extreme tiredness, unexplained chest pain or conjunctivitis (eye infection).

they are well as the learning is continuing in the classroom, even with only five days of school before our Reward Day next Friday.
