Stage 4 Technology

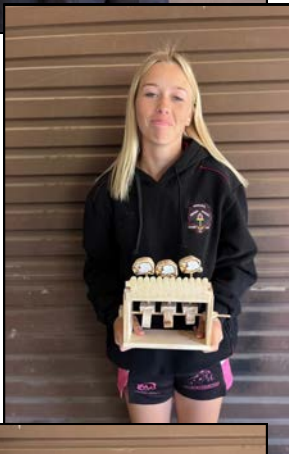
Cam Toys

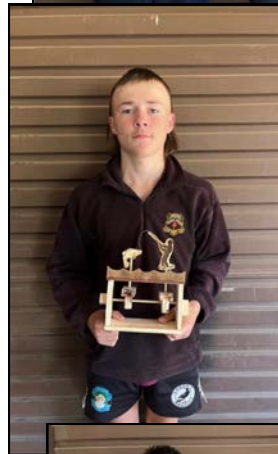
