




ATTENDANCE DRAW 95+%

Neurography is a meditative drawing process that combines psychology and art. The technique is said to link your conscious and subconscious mind and create new neural pathways.

The creative drawing process can help to reduce stress, transform subconscious beliefs and create an overall sense of wellbeing.

It was developed by Russian psychologist, creative entrepreneur and architect Paul Piskarev in 2014. Year 5/6 enjoyed experimenting with this process.


