Term 2 week 2: Resilience in 3/4



3/4 have been exploring mindfulness by focusing attention on one thing, appreciating that thing, and being observant about the details. They found a space to sit in the outdoor learning centre and journaled what they could see, think and feel when facing the left for five minutes, then repeated the process when facing the right.



Mindfulness is the practice of attention regulation. It involves three aspects: Where is our attention? Prioritise where it needs to be. Make it go there and stay there.
