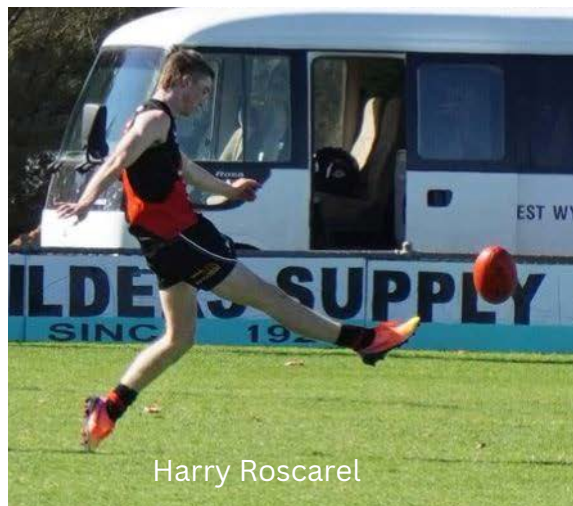

I saw a turtle, it was big. - Hannah Jenkins, Kindergarten

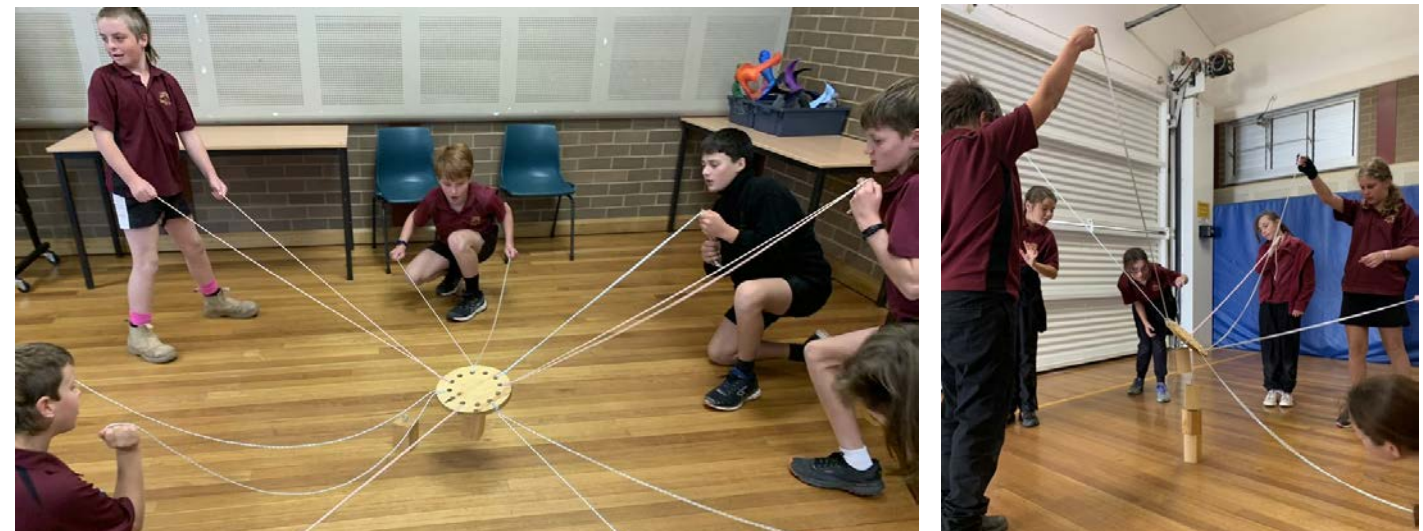
We went to preschool and saw a crocodile. The crocodile was not big but it was long. Hayden Ward, Year 1
