Students and staff thoroughly enjoyed the visit from Tim Cope last Friday. We were all enthralled and engaged by stories from his three-year adventure travelling from Mongolia to Hungary. Tim is passionate about inspiring young people to embrace challenge, to have the courage to write the script of their own life, and be open to the new, unfamiliar and unexpected, which really showed through his whole presentation.



## TIM COPE'S VISIT


If you have to rush, rush slowly.



Tim Cope is an adventurer, author and film-maker who is passionate about inspiring young people to explore the world that exists beyond their doorstep. He has studied as a wilderness guide in the Finnish and Russian subarctic, ridden a bicycle across Russia to China and rowed a boat along the Yenisey River through Siberia to the Arctic Ocean. His most renowned journey was a three year, 10,000km horseback trek from Mongolia to Hungary across the great Eurasian Steppe with his best friend (a dog) Tigon. He is the author of a number of books and has created several documentaries. Tim's latest work is *Tim & Tigon*, a book aimed at young readers and focusing on the friendship between himself and his adventure dog. Tim currently splits his time between Melbourne, Australia, where he is a regular speaker in schools, and remote Mongolia, where he takes people on nomadic adventures annually. Tim spoke to Yr 5 to 12 students and a number of staff on Friday 12th May about his 10,000km horseback journey and his relationship with Tigon. The audience was enthralled with his adventures, experiences and life lessons. Tim happily answered many questions and provided Tigon's footprint as a 'stamp' autograph to students. 




# THE RESILIENCE PROJECT™
