It has been another busy week with students involved in a range of sporting and educational programs. On Tuesday Rowan Duncan from NSW AFL came to Ungarie and worked with our primary students for what was the first of 4 sessions. He led students through a range of drills and skill-based activities to help develop their AFL skills.

This morning secondary students attended a vaping workshop run by Amanda Johnson from NSW Health. Staff and students learned valuable information about the dangers of the unregulated industry and the numerous health risks they pose. Did you know one vape, which would be consumed on average over a week, contains the same amount of nicotine as 8 packets of cigarettes!! The health risks are truly horrifying.

On Monday afternoon, staff attended a professional development session with Martin Hepple from The Resilience Project. All staff thoroughly enjoyed Martin's exuberant performance and learned about different ways to create authentic connections with all members of our school community.

Secondary teachers also completed an online Zoom meeting with Robert Tall from The Writer's Toolbox to learn ways to better implement this amazing digital platform within our school. I hope to run a parent information session in the upcoming weeks.

NSWCHS AFL (15'S) STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Tyler Crofts was selected in March as a member of the AFL Riverina South West U15's Team which played in the NSWCHS AFL (15's) State Championships in Albury from 9th May - 11th May. The weather was fresh but beautiful, with the sun shining each day.

The boys played five games over the three days, and they were lucky enough to be unbeaten in their pool, which put them into the Grand Final fighting for 1st place.

1st game was against West Darling who put up a good fight in defence and the Riverina boys were still figuring each other out as a team, but the boys came away with a win 29 - 14.

2nd game versus Sydney North, once again the boys were still trying to figure each other out but still managed to come away with the win 34 - 20.

3rd game against North Coast, the Riverina boys played well together and really started to blend. They were a strong team and won 48 - 2.
