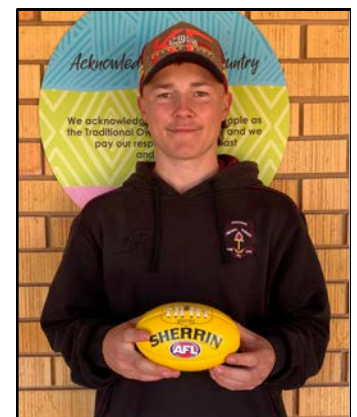

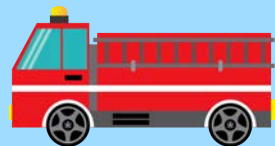


+ EMERGENCY SERVICES DAY +
