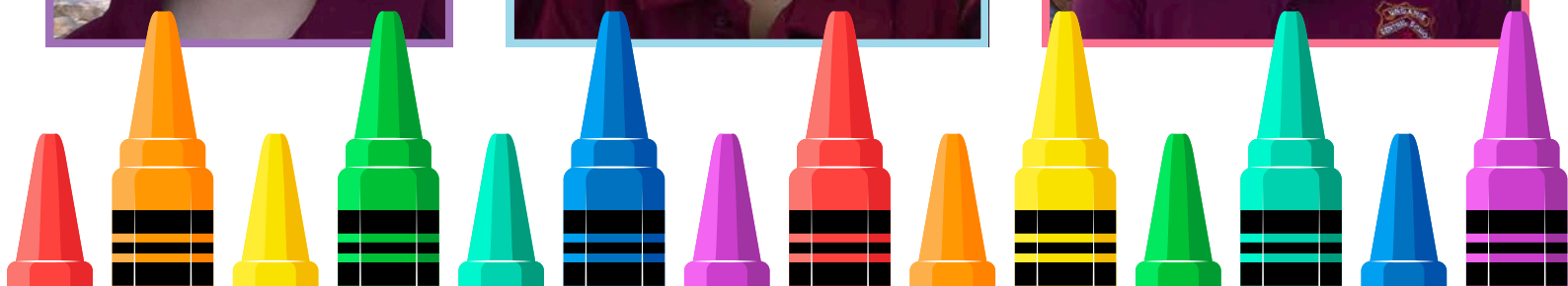
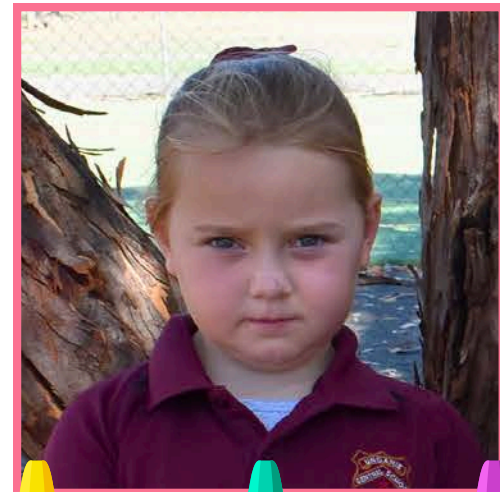
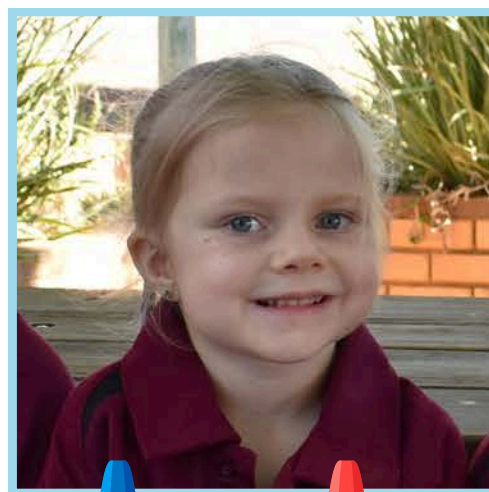


# First Day of Kindergarten 2025

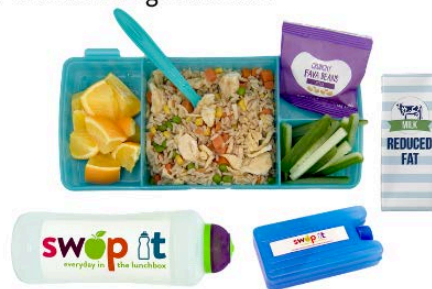


## Add a splash of rainbow
